

Assembly Instructions

- 1. Slide the end of the Hose (B) onto the Dryer's outlet, and secure by twisting to lock Hose.
- 2. Slide the desired Nozzle (A) onto the other end of the Hose (B) and secure in place by twisting to lock Nozzle.
- 3. To replace filter, press tab on filter cover and pull outward. Replace old fileter wit a new one. To replace cover,insert Tabs of filter cover into slots in Dryer, press cover in place securely.







Operating Instructions

- 1. Turn on the Power Switch (D) and adjust the Air Speed Control Switch (E) until you find the appropriate air speed.
- 2. Clean the Air Filter (C) regularly. To prevent blockage of the air intake and protect the motor, regularly remove and clean or replace the air filter.
- 3. When it's time to change the dryer filter, remove the three filter cover and insert a new filter. Make sure the covers is snapped securely into place.
- 4. If the dryer stops working suddenly, please ensure that it is plugged in. If the dryer is connected to a power supply, but is still not working, contact PetEdge Technical Support for more information, or to schedule maintenance—DO NOT disassemble and attempt to repair, as this will void any and all warranties.

Maintenance Instructions

- 1. Keep the dryer clean by wiping down with a damp cloth.
- 2. Never clean the unit with water.
- 3. When not in use, unplug and store the dryer in a dry indoor place, out of reach of children.

Safety Instructions

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury to persons when using your appliance, please follow these basic safety precautions.

- 1. Read ALL instructions before using this appliance.
- 2. Use this dryer only for its intended purpose for drying dogs and cats.
- 3. Never unplug the dryer by pulling on the power cord.

- 7. Unplug the dryer before cleaning, before making any repairs, or when dryer is not in use.
- 8. This dryer should be connected to a grounded power outlet with the proper electrical supply. See operating instructions.
- 9. Repair or replace any loose or worn parts immediately.
- 10. Do not operate the dryer when parts are missing or broken.
- 11. Do not use the dryer outdoors.
- 12. Do not operate the dryer if it is damaged or malfunctioning in any way.
- 13. Avoid contacting hot surfaces.
- 14. Do not wrap cord around motor enclosure. Continuous heat from the motor may damage cord insulation and cause electric shock.
