Parts List: Door Handles (2) Bottom and Top Panels (2) predrilled holes are on sides Back Panel (1) total 25x predrilled holes are on back Right Side Panel (1) Left Side Panel (1) B Front Panel w/Doors (1) Hex Screws (25) Screws (4) - for Door Handles (4) D C **B Tools Needed:** Allen Wrench (included)

Assembly: (steps 1-2)



Phillips Head Screwdriver

General instructions: Always align Cabinet pieces over pre-drilled holes, and finger-tighten the Screws (G). Once all are in place, go back and tighten securely using included allen wrench.


Brace Back Panel (C) and attach Bottom and Top Panels (B)

Repeat for Left Side Panel (E).




Assembly Continued: (steps 3-5)

Attach Front Panel w/Doors (F) to cabinet assembly, making sure door latches are on top.




Attach Door Handles (A) using provided Screws (H); tighten from inside with a Phillips Head Screwdriver.



5. Tighten all bolts throughout.

To attach assembled Tub Cabinet to assembled Everyday Pro Tub, TP364

- Carefully position Tub Cabinet atop Tub, lining up edges and corners over pre-drilled holes.
- Finger-tighten 4 Bolts (G) on right side, then on left side.
- 3. To finish, tighten all bolts securely and evenly with a wrench
